

## **ADMINISTRATION OF OATHS**

Our Hawaii Legislature passed Act 110 and same has been signed into law by the Governor. ***This act gives licensed Hawaii CSRs in good standing the authority to swear in witnesses.*** In other words, you do not need to be a notary. We do not have the new HRS Section and Paragraph number yet. That will be forthcoming in November of this year.

When swearing in under this new Act, **your certificate should not have any reference to “notary” nor should you use your notary seal.** For the time being the following wording can be used in your certificate:

*...“that prior to being examined was by me duly sworn or affirmed pursuant to Act 110 of the 2010 Session of the Hawaii State Legislature”...*
